HIV/AIDS Program: 2004- 2013

Policy and program management. Serve in the National AIDS Management Center which helps develop national AIDS strategies, monitor and evaluation HIV/AIDS care program nationwide, such as designing M&E framework, indicators for HIV prevention and care programs within the universal public health care system, bridging governmental sectors with non-governmental and other community-based organizations to work in partnership according to the national HIV/AIDS policies and strategies. Function as the chief of Care and Treatment Section in the Global AIDS Program, Thailand. Provide technical supports to various levels, i.e, national, regional and provincial, to strengthen and scale up quality HIV prevention and care programs in 12 public health regions across Thailand.

Epidemiology: Serve on FETP (Field Epidemiology Training Program) committee to provide technical consultation to epidemiology trainees. Drafted and developed Thailand national guidelines for AIDS case reporting system (506/1 report) with the Bureau of Epidemiology, Ministry of Public Health. Helped the Ministry of Public Health on strengthening HIV/AIDS information system, e.g., data collection plan and data utilization. Provide technical support on surveillance system to various healthcare parties.

HIV prevention: Provide technical expertise in HIV and STI prevention with various populations including sex workers, men who have sex with men, prisoners, youth and general

population. Development a curriculum for healthcare providers on Sexual Health Care for Men Who Have Sex with Men (MSM) and the STI management, and serve as a key trainer to health care providers in various sites.

HIV care and treatment: Collaborate with Ministry to develop national guideline for HIV VCT in Thailand with the Ministry of Public Health, national guideline of HIV care and treatment. Implement Quality Improvement of HIV Care model (HIVQUAL-T) which is nationally scaled up by Thailand's Ministry of Public Health. Provide technical advices, develop training curriculum for HIV quality improvement of care and train local healthcare staff in Thailand.

Research on HIV and STI :

Acted as co-investigator in the following studies; a) a randomized clinical trial of acyclovir suppressive therapy among HIV and HSV-2 co-infection in women, b) a cross-sectional survey on HIV prevalence and risk behavior among Thai female sex workers using respondent-driven sampling , and c) Phase 1 study of safety and acceptability of UC-781 vaginal microbicide in women and their partners.
